1 1/8 MILES. (1.39) 67TH RUNNING OF THE SANTA CATALINA. Grade II. Purse \$200,000 FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$200 each to accompany the nomination or by supplementary nomination of \$4,000 by time of entry. \$2,000 additional to start, with \$200,000 guaranteed of which \$120,000 to first, \$40,000 to second, \$24,000 to third, \$12,000 to fourth and \$4,000 to fifth. All Early Bird nominees to the 2005 Santa Anita Derby (Closing Date, Thursday, December 9, 2004) are automatically eligible to the Santa Catalina Stakes with all fees waived. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$55,000 at one mile or over since December 1, 2004 allowed 3 lbs.; \$55,000 at any distance since December 1, 2004, 5 lbs.; of \$25,000 at one mile or over or \$30,000 at any distance, 7 lbs. Total earnings in non-claiming races will be used in determining the preference of horses with equal weights. Maiden and Claiming races not considered. Starters to be named through the entry box by the closing time of entries. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed with 150 early and 5 regular nominations.

DECLAN'S MOON broke in and bumped the runner-up, stalked three deep then outside that rival, bid three wide on the second turn and into the stretch, gained the advantage outside foes just past the eighth pole and pulled clear under left handed urging while drifting in some. GOING WILD bumped between horses at the start, pulled his way between foes then angled in on the first turn and stalked the pace, bid along the rail on the second turn and in the stretch, could not match the winner late but continued willingly to hold second. SPANISH CHESTNUT bumped at the start, sped to the early lead under a loose rein, set the pace a bit off the rail under a rating hold, fought back between horses on the second turn and until just past midstretch and weakened but held third. GO COYOTE JOE saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. JULIESUGARDADDY settled inside then came off the rail, went three deep on the backstretch, dropped back some on the second turn and gave way. SNACK unhurried outside a rival then off the rail, took a bad step and broke down nearing the second turn.
