 By subscription of \$300 on Friday, February 10, 2006 for The Southwest, The Rebel and The Arkansas Derby. \$2,000 to pass the entry box and \$2,000 additional to start, with \$250,000 Guaranteed of which \$150,000 to the Owner of the winner, \$50,000 to second, \$25,000 to third, \$12,500 to fourth, \$7,500 to fifth and \$5,000 to sixth. **WEIGHTS:** 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$35,000 at a mile or over in 2006, allowed 3 lbs.; \$30,000 at a mile or over at any time allowed 5 lbs.; \$20,000 at any distance, allowed 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered). In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings, excluding money won in restricted races (See reverse side for additional starting limitation information). **LAWYER RON** encouraged a bit early, clear early through a quick opening quarter, hard rated backstretch, continued to show a daylight advantage turning for home, held the runner up safe late. **STEPPEWOLFER** void of early foot, made a good advance into contention three then four wide in the second turn, late challenge on the winner, getting to that one, not enough. **RED RAYMOND** off the pace toward the inside, called on for some run turning for home, best of the rest. **MUSIC SCHOOL** settled within striking distance, mild bid in the second turn, hung in the drive. **MARK OF SUCCESS** forwardly placed along the inside, asked for some run turning for home, came up empty for the drive. **SHARP ATTACK** bothered slightly when forwardly placed in the first turn, continued to prompt the issue outside, faded in the drive. **KINGSFIELD** void of early foot, picked up a couple of tiring foes. **CELLULOID HERO** raced three wide and well back off the pace, lacked a late bid. **TRAVELIN LEROY** closest to the early pace, began to retreat after a half. **AGRAPHA** off slow, rushed up into the first turn, got out, rank, stopped in the drive.
