1 1/8 MILES. (147) 83RD RUNNING OF THE WOOD MEMORIAL. Grade I. Purse \$750,000 FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$750 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$3,500 to pass the entry box; \$4,000 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 123 lbs. The field will be limited to 14 starters, with an also eligible list if necessary. Preference will be given in the following order; Grade I winners; Grade I placed; Grade II winners; Grade III winners; Total earnings. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. A bonus of \$100,000 (which will follow the horse) will be presented to the trainer of the horse which wins both The Wood Memorial and The Kentucky Derby. Closed Saturday, March 24, 2007 with 25 Nominations.

NOBIZ LIKE SHOBIZ was urged from the gate to take position on the rail, argued the pace from the inside, was hustled to maintain that position into the second turn, responded when joined from the outside by ANY GIVEN SATURDAY nearing the stretch, put away that rival leaving the eighth pole then dug in resolutely under steady left handed pressure and held SIGHTSEEING safe to the finish. SIGHTSEEING raced in hand along the inside early, came wide nearing the stretch, responded when set down and finished gamely outside but could not get by the winner. ANY GIVEN SATURDAY raced close up outside, was caught wide on both turns, took a run at the winner nearing the stretch, battled that rival into the final furlong and faded in deep stretch. SUMMER DOLDRUMS was hustled up three wide, contested the pace, continued on between rivals on the second turn and tired turning for home. REPTILIAN SMARTS was outrun early, raced three wide and had no response when roused. FLASHSTORM was hustled from the gate, contested the pace while between rivals and was finished after the opening half mile.
