OFFICIAL KENTUCKY DERBY PROGRAMS AVAILABLE NATIONWIDE

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (Friday, April 15, 2022) – Fans, party hosts, horseplayers and memorabilia collectors can now have official Kentucky Derby 148 souvenir programs shipped right to their doorstep in time for Kentucky Derby Day on Saturday, May 7.

Advance online ordering of programs is now available at www.publications.churchilldowns.com.

These glossy programs are identical to those sold on track at Churchill Downs on Kentucky Derby Day, with full past performances for the entire card, as well as feature articles on Derby personalities, history and traditions.

Programs, which cost \$15 and are approximately 120 pages, will go to print following the May 2 post position draw for the Kentucky Derby and will ship May 5 via FedEx Priority Overnight for morning delivery on Friday, May 6.

There is a minimum of five programs per order. Payment will only be accepted online via major credit card.

The last day to order is Friday, April 29.

ABOUT CHURCHILL DOWNS RACETRACK

Churchill Downs Racetrack ("CDRT"), the world's most legendary racetrack, has been the home of The Kentucky Derby, the longest continually held annual sporting event in the United States, since 1875. Located in Louisville, CDRT features a series of themed race days during Derby Week, including the Kentucky Oaks, and conducts Thoroughbred horse racing during three race meets in the Spring, September, and the Fall. CDRT is located on 175 acres and has a one-mile dirt track, a 7/8-mile turf track, a stabling area, and provides seating for approximately 60,000 guests. The saddling paddock and the stable area has barns sufficient to accommodate 1,400 horses and a 114-room dormitory for backstretch personnel. CDRT also has a year-round simulcast wagering facility. www.ChurchillDowns.com.
