WELL-BALANCED FIELD OF NINE TO LINE UP FOR THURSDAY'S UNBRIDLED SIDNEY; HURRICANE DEBBIE COULD GIVE WARD FOURTH KENTUCKY JUVENILE VICTORY; DEFENDING CHAMPION SET PIECE (GB) HEADS FIELD OF 12 FOR THURSDAY'S OPENING VERSE

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (Saturday, April 30, 2022) – An evenly matched field of nine fillies and mares, headed by multiple stakes winner Change of Control, passed the entry box Saturday for Thursday's 12th running of the \$200,000 Unbridled Sidney (Listed) going 5 ¹/₂ furlongs on the new Matt Winn Turf Course.

The 11-race Thurby, presented by Old Forester, program begins at 12:45 p.m. (all times Eastern) with the Unbridled Sidney going as the afternoon's 10th race with a 5:45 post time.

Perry Harrison's Change of Control, whose only loss in four starts over the grass at Churchill Downs came in last year's Unbridled Sidney, is trained by **Michelle Lovell** and comes into Thursday's race off a fourth-place finish behind two-time Grade I winner **Campanelle (IRE)** in the Giant's Causeway (Listed) at Keeneland.

Regular Colby Hernandez will be aboard and break from post position five.

Another top contender in the field is **Castleton Lyons' Brooke Marie**.

Trained by **Eddie Kenneally**, Brooke Marie comes into Thursday's race off a victory in the Monrovia (GII) going 6 ¹/₂ furlongs at Santa Anita on April 9. Luis Saez has the mount and will break from position two.

The field for the Unbridled Sidney, with riders, from the inside, is: **Social Chatter** (Rafael Bejarano), Brooke Marie (Saez), **Ambassador Luna** (Corey Lanerie), **In Good Spirits** (John Velazquez), Change of Control (Colby Hernandez), **Catch a Bid** (Brian Hernandez Jr.), **Goin' Good** (Tyler Gaffalione), **Tobys Heart** (Jose Ortiz) and **Bullseye Beauty** (James Graham).

Gabriel Duignan and **Mrs. Charlie O'Connor's Hurricane Debbie**, an 8-length winner on debut at Keeneland on April 14, heads a field of a dozen 2-year-olds entered Saturday for Thursday's 28th running of the \$200,000 Kentucky Juvenile going five furlongs on the main track.

The Kentucky Juvenile will go as the ninth race on Thursday's 11-race program with a 5:11 p.m. post time.

Trained by three-time race winner **Wesley Ward**, including last year with **Averly Jane**, Hurricane Debbie will break from post 11 and be ridden by **John Velazquez**.

Four other debut winners from Keeneland are in the field including the Luis Mendez-trained King Adrock. Owned by Jim Hernandez, King Adrock won the first race of the recently completed Spring Meet by 5 lengths and will have Flavien Prat back aboard Thursday and break from post three.

The field for the Kentucky Juvenile, with riders from the inside, is: Tom's Regret (Tyler Baze,), Lone Leader (Corey Lanerie, 118), King Adrock (Prat, 120), Ferrari Kid (Frankie Pennington, 120), Mr. Gordy (Gerardo Corrales, 120), Cool Spirit (Colby Hernandez, 118), Hill of Tara (Edgar Morales, 118), Ryvit (Joel Rosario, 118), Simply Super (Tyler Gaffalione, 120), Baytown Lovely (Jack Gilligan, 117), Hurricane Debbie (Velazquez, 117) and The Big Wam (Joe Talamo, 118).

Juddmonte's Set Piece (GB), a winner of four of his five career starts over the turf at Churchill Downs, heads a field of xx 4-year-olds and up entered Saturday for Thursday's 17th running of the \$160,000 Opening Verse Overnight Stakes (Listed) going a mile on the Matt Winn Turf Course.

The Opening Verse will go as the eighth race on Thursday's 11-race program with a 4:37 p.m. post time.

A winner of three stakes here last year highlighted by the Wise Dan (GII), Set Piece comes into Thursday's race off a seventhplace finish in the Maker's Mark Mile (G1) at Keeneland in which he was beaten only 2 lengths. Trained by Brad Cox, Set Piece will be ridden by Florent Geroux and break from post position six.

The field for the Opening Verse, with riders from the inside, is: Monarchs Glen (GB) (Ricardo Santana Jr.), Beatbox (Flavien Prat), Hidden Stash (Rafael Bejarano), Kentucky Ghost (Tyler Gaffalione), Mr Dumas (Rey Gutierrez), Set Piece (GB) (Geroux), Spectacular Gem (Ronney Betancourt), Capitivating Moon (Jareth Loveberry), Gray's Fable (Luis Saez), Spanish Kingdom (Brian Hernandez Jr.), Max K. O. (Irad Ortiz Jr.) and Kentucky Pharoah (Julien Leparoux).

Churchill Downs Racetrack ("CDRT"), the world's most legendary racetrack, has been the home of The Kentucky Derby, the longest continually held annual sporting event in the United States, since 1875.
