# ROAD TO KENTUCKY DERBY CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES WINDS DOWN WITH BLUE GRASS, SANTA ANITA DERBY, WOOD MEMORIAL

**LOUISVILLE, Ky. (Thursday, April 7, 2022)** – Derby fans will be on the edge of their seats Saturday afternoon as a trio of Road to the Kentucky Derby Championship Series events will give a more clear picture of the field for "America's Greatest Race."

Saturday's Championship Series action will start at 4:45 p.m. (all times Eastern) with the \$750,000 Wood Memorial (Grade II) at Aqueduct featuring the duo of undefeated 3-year-old graded stakes winners **Early Voting** and **Morello**. A half-hour later, Grade II winner **Smile Happy** will face 11 rivals in the \$1 million Blue Grass (GI) at Keeneland. The action will close at approximately 5:30 p.m. when the speedy two-time Grade II winner **Forbidden Kingdom** takes on runaway 15-length Robert B. Lewis (GIII) champ **Messier** in the \$750,000 Santa Anita Derby (GI).

All three races will award the top four finishers points on a 100-40-20-10 scale toward qualification to the \$3 million Kentucky Derby presented by Woodford Reserve (GI) on Saturday, May 7.

Fans can wager on all three races on <u>www.TwinSpires.com</u>, the official wagering provider of Churchill Downs and the Kentucky Derby. The trio of stakes will be broadcast on NBC from 4:30-6 p.m.

**SMILE HAPPY TABBED AS 9-5 FAVORITE IN \$1 MILLION BLUE GRASS** – Lucky Seven Stable's \$400,000 Kentucky Jockey Club (Grade II) winner Smile Happy was made the early 9-5 favorite against 11 rivals as he attempts to stamp himself as one of the top choices for this year's Kentucky Derby (GI) in Saturday's \$1 million Blue Grass (GI) at Keeneland.

The 98<sup>th</sup> running of the Blue Grass will go as Race 9 of 11 at 5:15 p.m. First post is 12:30 p.m. The Blue Grass will be televised on NBC from 4:30-6 p.m. and fans can wager on <u>www.TwinSpires.com</u>, the official wagering provider of Churchill Downs and the Kentucky Derby. The Blue Grass will award a total of 170 qualifying points to the top four finishers on a 100-40-20-10 scale toward a spot in the starting gate in the Run for the Roses.

Smile Happy, trained by **Kenny McPeek**, made his 3-year-old debut in the \$400,000 Risen Star (GII) at Fair Grounds where he closed from five lengths off the early pace to finish second behind top Kentucky Derby contender **Epicenter**. Smile Happy will be ridden by **Corey Lanerie**, who was aboard the colt for his victory in the Kentucky Jockey Club.

Another top contender in the Blue Grass is **Jeff Drown**'s Risen Star third-place finisher **Zandon**. Trained by **Chad Brown**, Zandon finished a half-length behind Smile Happy in the Risen Star after encountering trouble at the start. The son of Upstart will be ridden by **Flavien Prat** from post 4.

Lewis (GIII) champ **Messier** in Saturday's \$750,000 Santa Anita Derby (GI).

The 1 1/8-mile Santa Anita Derby will go as Race 6 of 12 with a post time of 5:30 p.m. The Road to the Kentucky Derby Championship Series race will award the top four finishing horses points on a 100-40-20-10 scale towards a spot in the starting gate on the first Saturday in May.

Forbidden Kingdom, trained by Hall of Famer **Richard Mandella**, drew post No. 4 for the Santa Anita Derby. The son of American Pharoah won his last two starts, the \$200,000 San Vicente (GII) and \$400,000 San Felipe (GII), in front-running fashion. The chestnut colt will be ridden by **Juan Hernandez** at morning line odds of 6-5.

Drawn one post to his outside is SF Racing, Starling Racing, Madaket Stables, Robert Masterson, Jay Schoenfarber, Waves Edge Capital, Catherine Donovan, Golconda Stable and Siena Farm's \$200,000 Robert B. Lewis winner Messier. Now trained by Tim Yakteen, Messier became one of Southern California's top 3-year-old prospects as a juvenile when he won the \$100,000 Bob Hope (GIII) at Del Mar and followed that with a one-length runner-up finish to Slow Down Andy in the \$300,000 Los Alamitos Futurity (GII). The Empire Maker colt dominated his 3-year-old bow in the Robert B. Lewis. Messier will be ridden by John Velazquez and was made the even-money morning line favorite by oddsmaker Jon White.

**UNDEFEATED GRADED STAKES WINNERS EARLY VOTING, MORELLO CLASH IN GRADE II WOOD MEMORIAL** – Undefeated graded stakes winning colts **Early Voting** and **Morello** will clash against six other 3-year-old rivals in Saturday's \$750,000 Wood Memorial (Grade II) at Aqueduct.

The 1 1/8-mile Wood Memorial, which offers points on a 100-40-20-10 scale towards the Kentucky Derby (GI), will go as Race 8 of 11 with a post time of 4:45 p.m.

Klaravich Stables' Early Voting, who is undefeated in two starts, drew post No. 3 in the Wood Memorial. Trained by Chad Brown, Early Voting was a front-running 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>-length winner of the \$250,000 Withers (GIII) in early February. A son of former Horse of the Year Gun Runner, Early Voting will attempt to give New York-based Brown his first victory in the Wood Memorial.

"He went first time around two turns and he passed the test well," Brown said. "He definitely gained experience and he appears to be training well. He prefers to be forwardly placed, so hopefully he'll be there again."

Early Voting will be ridden by 2019 Wood Memorial-winning jockey Jose Ortiz.

**Diamond T Racing, Blue Lion Thoroughbreds** and **Craig Taylor**'s \$300,000 Gotham (GIII) winner Morello will put his unbeaten streak on the line Saturday from post 5. Trained by Hall of Famer **Steve Asmussen**, Morello has steadily progressed in distance since his six-furlong debut in late November at Aqueduct. In his next start, the son of Classic Empire won the \$100,000 Jimmy Winkfield at seven furlongs before winning the one-mile Gotham. Morello will once again be ridden by **Jose Lezcano**.

**LOUISIANA DERBY WINNER EPICENTER MADE 5-1 FAVORITE IN FINAL DERBY FUTURE WAGER POOL** – Fans will have the final pari-mutuel opportunity to bet on this year's Kentucky Derby in advance of the May 7 race beginning Thursday at noon (all times Eastern) through Saturday at 4:30 p.m. for Pool 5 of the Kentucky Derby Future Wager ("KDFW").

Pool 5 of the KDFW features 24 betting interests and the 5-1 early morning line favorite is **Winchell Thoroughbreds**' \$1 million TwinSpires.com Louisiana Derby (Grade II) winner **Epicenter**.

Unlike the previous three-day Kentucky Derby Future Wager opportunities, Pool 5 will feature an early start on Thursday and will close Saturday at 4:30 p.m. prior to the first Road to the Kentucky Derby Championship Series event held that day.

Nine individual betting interests in Saturday's pool are expected to run in that day's \$1 million Blue Grass (GI), \$750,000 Santa Anita Derby (GI) and \$750,000 Wood Memorial (GI).

Betting for Pool 5 of the KDFW is available at simulcast centers throughout the country as well as most wagering platforms, including <u>www.TwinSpires.com</u>, the official ADW of the Kentucky Derby and Churchill Downs.

Epicenter stamped himself as the early Kentucky Derby favorite with an authoritative 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>-length score in the Louisiana Derby. The **Steve Asmussen** trainee was offered in each of the first four KDFW pools and closed at 52-1 in Pool 1, which closed Nov. 28. Over the next three months, bettors quickly began to take notice of Epicenter's Kentucky Derby potential as he closed at odds of 24-1 in Pools 2 and 3 and 13-1 in Pool 4.

One of the other top betting choices in Pool 5 of the KDFW is **Lucky Seven Stable**'s \$400,000 Kentucky Jockey Club (GII) winner **Smile Happy**. The Runhappy colt, trained by **Kenny McPeek**, is the 9-5 morning line favorite in Saturday's Blue Grass at Keeneland.

Grade II winner **Nest** headlines a field of eight 3-year-old fillies in Friday's \$600,000 Ashland (GI) at Keeneland. The Ashland will award the top 4 finishers points on a 100-40-20-10 scale toward the \$1.25 million Longines Kentucky Oaks (GI). The Ashland will be the featured ninth race at 5:16 p.m. ...

Top California-based filly **Adare Manor** tops a field of five that entered the \$400,000 Santa Anita Oaks (GII). The race, which offers 100 points to the winner, 40 to the runner-up, 20 for third and 10 for fourth toward the Kentucky Oaks, has a post time of 4:30 p.m.

Busher Invitational winner Venti Valentine heads a field of eight 3-year-old fillies entered in Saturday's \$250,000 Gazelle (GIII), a Championship Series race on the Road to the Kentucky Oaks. The Gazelle will offer 170 total points to the top 4 finishers on a 100-40-20-10 scale. The 1 1/8-mile Gazelle goes as Race 11 at 5:55 p.m. ...

**Gold Mark**'s Arkansas Derby winner **Cyberknife** arrived Wednesday morning at Churchill Downs to begin his Derby preparation. Cyberknife is stabled in trainer Brad Cox's Barn 22 along with Derby-bound stablemates **Tawny Port** and **Zozos**. ...

Winchell Thoroughbreds' Epicenter is scheduled to work Sunday at Churchill Downs for the first time since his TwinSpires.com Louisiana Derby victory. The second-place finisher in the Louisiana Derby, Zozos, is slated to work Saturday, according to their respective connections....

Briland Farm's multiple graded stakes winner Secret Oath returned to trainer D. Wayne Lukas' Barn 40 at Churchill Downs Tuesday afternoon. The Longines Kentucky Oaks-bound filly finished third in last Saturday's Arkansas Derby (GI). ...

Hall of Fame trainer **Todd Pletcher** is planning on keeping a string of horses at Churchill Downs throughout the spring and summer. Pletcher will be stabled in Barn 35. Another trainer that plans to keep a large presence of horses at Churchill Downs is **Chad Brown**. His horses will be stabled in Barn 25. ...

Trainer Mark Casse confirmed Florida Derby (GI) fourth-place finisher Pappacap would target the \$500,000 Pat Day Mile presented by LG&E and KU (GII). ...

Arkansas Derby (GI) runner-up **Barber Road** will stay at Oaklawn for about a week before he returns to Churchill Downs, according to trainer **John Ortiz**. ...

UAE Derby (GII) winner **Crown Pride (JPN)** will remain stabled in one of Churchill Downs' Quarantine barns until the Kentucky Derby. The colt typically trains at 7:40 a.m. ...

Training hours at Churchill Downs are 5:30-10 a.m. with two track renovation breaks from 7-7:30 a.m. and 8:30-9 a.m. The exclusive 15-minute window for Kentucky Derby and Oaks horses from 7:30-7:45 a.m. will begin Saturday, April 23. ...

Jockey **Umberto Rispoli**, one of the top riders in Southern California, will shift his tack to Churchill Downs for the upcoming Spring Meet. Rispoli, a native of Italy, was a member of the Hong Kong Jockey Club before moving to the U.S. in 2019. ...

The Road to the Kentucky Oaks will close Sunday at Keeneland for the seven-furlong, \$400,000 Beaumont. The race will award the top four finishers points on a 10-4-2-1 scale.

After this weekend, the Road to the Kentucky Derby will conclude with the \$400,000 Lexington (GIII) over 1 1/16 miles at Keeneland. Points will be awarded on a 20-8-4-2 scale. ### ABOUT CHURCHILL DOWNS RACETRACK

Churchill Downs Racetrack ("CDRT"), the world's most legendary racetrack, has been the home of The Kentucky Derby, the longest continually held annual sporting event in the United States, since 1875. Located in Louisville, CDRT features a series of themed race days during Derby Week, including the Kentucky Oaks, and conducts Thoroughbred horse racing during three race meets in the Spring, September, and the Fall. CDRT is located on 175 acres and has a one-mile dirt track, a 7/8-mile turf track, a stabling area, and provides seating for approximately 60,000 guests. The saddling paddock and the stable area has barns sufficient to accommodate 1,400 horses and a 114-room dormitory for backstretch personnel.
