

FIRST SATURDAY IN MAY

The Kentucky Derby has been staged on the first Saturday in May on 92 occasions.

A 73-year streak (1946-2019) was snapped in 2020 when the Kentucky Derby was delayed until Sept. 5, 2020 because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Derby was staged outside the month of May on three occasions: Monday, April 29, 1901; Saturday, June 9, 1945; and Saturday, Sept. 5, 2020.

The Derby has been run on a Saturday on 115 occasions and each day of the week except Sunday. The last time it wasn't staged on a Saturday was 1910.
