## Footnotes

AUTHENTIC took command nearing the wire the first time well removed from the inside, stayed in the four path around the first turn while clear, maintained a clear advantage down the backstretch and into the second turn, met the challenge of TIZ THE LAW inside the three-eighths pole, clung to a narrow lead turning for home, brushed with that one near the three-sixteenths marker, turned back TIZ THE LAW approaching the furlong grounds, shook clear and held steadily. TIZ THE LAW away in good order, was close up three wide into the turn, moved out five to six wide through the first turn, tracked outside in hand, ranged up into far turn, engaged in earnest inside the three furlong pole, came to even terms just past the five-sixteenths marker, brushed with AUTHENTIC in upper stretch, was rebuffed a furlong out but kept on willingly. MR. BIG NEWS tracked from mid pack three deep around the first bend, moved out to the five path on the backstretch, came under a ride passing the seven-sixteenths, progressed five wide around far turn, drifted a bit when straightening, took aim on the leaders into the lane, leveled off but fought on to preserve the minor award. HONOR A. P. hesitated at the start, was unhurried while four wide into the first turn, looped into the back stretch six deep, made a steady sweeping move through the second turn, fanned into the nine path into the stretch, continued on and was making progress. MAX PLAYER reserved off of the inside, moved out between rivals four to five wide on the far turn, churned on in traffic and improved position. STORM THE COURT was well placed along the inside, attended the pace in hand through the second turn, drifted around a bit through the stretch but failed to make headway. ENFORCEABLE was close up along the inside, was caught in tight and bumped with MAJOR FED into the first turn, settled while well positioned, came under a ride at the half mile pole but toiled in vain. NY TRAFFIC tracked between foes inside TIZ THE LAW into first turn, tipped out into the five path around the bend, stayed within range to the three furlong marker, tacked inward on the second turn, altered back out nearing the quarter pole, but weakened once straightened for the lane. NECKER ISLAND was unhurried in the two to three path, moved out eight deep into lane, drifted inward in the stretch and passed some tired ones. MAJOR FED was keen to place between foes, jostled into first turn, leveled into stride on the backstretch while close up, was caught in traffic and altered course when NY TRAFFIC came out near the five-sixteenths pole, stayed on to the stretch and tired. SOLE VOLANTE was squeezed at the start, was unhurried two wide through the first turn, settled along the inside but lacked a response. WINNING IMPRESSION tucked in to save ground, settled in mid pack, lost position from the half to the quarter pole, wheeled out and passed a few. MONEY MOVES was hard to place in traffic, bumped with MAJOR FED into the first turn, settled three deep between horses, but came up empty before going a mile. ATTACHMENT RATE came in bumping SOLE VOLANTE at the start, was forwardly placed four to five wide, was put to pressure with nine-sixteenths to run, but tired and steadily faded. SOUTH BEND lobbed along saving ground, commenced a drive into the second turn, shifted out six wide and offered his bid, came eight wide, but caved and retreated.
