BREEDERS' CUP JUVENILE TURF SPRINT WINNER TWILIGHT GLEAMING (IRE) HEADLINES SATURDAY NIGHT'S MAMZELLE AT CHURCHILL DOWNS

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (Wednesday, May 11, 2022) – **Stonestreet Stables**' \$1 million Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint (Grade II) winner **Twilight Gleaming (IRE)** is set to face 11 rivals in Saturday night's featured \$160,000 Mamzelle Overnight Stakes at Churchill Downs.

The five-furlong Mamzelle, run over the Matt Winn Turf Course, is carded as Race 9 of 11 with a post time of 10:11 p.m. (all times Eastern). First post for Downs After Dark is 6 p.m.

Trained by **Wesley Ward**, the speedy Twilight Gleaming scored a half-length victory in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint at Del Mar. The daughter of **National Defense** (**GB**) made her 3-year-old debut last month in the \$200,000 Palisades at Keeneland where she was narrowly defeated as the 4-5 favorite. **Tyler Gaffalione** has the mount Saturday from post No. 5.
