## 'ALL OTHERS' 4-5 FAVORITE, CHANCER McPATRICK 9-1 AT CONCLUSION OF KENTUCKY DERBY FUTURE WAGER POOL 1

**LOUISVILLE, Ky.** (Friday, Nov. 1, 2024) – Six months in advance of Kentucky Derby 151, the pari-mutuel field of "All Other Colts and Geldings" closed as the odds-on 4-5 favorite in Pool 1 of the Kentucky Derby Future Wager (KDFW) and Hopeful (Grade I) and Champagne (GI) winner **Chancer McPatrick**, who runs in Friday's Breeders' Cup Juvenile (GI), was the 9-1 second choice.

Other horses who attracted mild interest from bettors were Breeders' Futurity (GI) winner **East Avenue** (11-1) and Iroquois (GIII) winner **Jonathan's Way** (19-1), who both run in Friday's Juvenile.

Total handle for the Oct. 30-Nov. 1 KDFW pool – the first of six scheduled wagering pools in advance of the 151<sup>st</sup> running of the Kentucky Derby presented by Woodford Reserve (GI) on Saturday, May 3 – was \$174,785 (\$138,536 in the Win pool and \$36,249 in Exactas), a 6.4% jump from last year's \$164,278 (\$132,033 in the Win pool and \$32,245 in Exactas).

Inaugurated in 1999, the Kentucky Derby Future Wager has been offered for a 27th consecutive year.

Other Future Wager dates are set for Nov. 28-Dec. 1 (Pool 2); Jan. 17-19 (Pool 3); Feb. 14-16 (Pool 4); March 14-16 (Pool 5) and April 3-5 (Pool 6). Pool 2 will also feature the Kentucky Derby Sire Future Wager, while Pool 5 will include the Longines Kentucky Oaks Future Wager.
