Name Origin: Race is named for the 2010 Champion Older Male Blame, who defeated previously unbeaten Zenyatta by a head in that year's \$5 million Breeders' Cup Classic (Grade I) at Churchill Downs. Owned and bred by Claiborne Farm and Adele B. Dilschneider, Blame won nine of 13 starts and \$4,368,214 while under the care of Churchill Downs-based trainer Al Stall Jr. He won four of his five starts at the legendary Louisville track, including the 2009 Clark Handicap (GII) and 2010 Stephen Foster Handicap (GI). His racing career concluded Nov. 6, 2010 when Blame, guided by Garrett Gomez, handed Hall of Fame mare Zenyatta her only loss in 20 career starts, which garnered the 2010 NTRA "Moment of the Year."
