Name Origin: Named in honor of the Thoroughbred retirement farm located in nearby Prospect, Ky. in Oldham County. The 25.1-acre property was originally a Thoroughbred farm owned by George and Janet Falk, dubbed Sunny Acres Farm. The property is now owned by Churchill Downs Incorporated CEO Bill Carstanjen, who partnered with the Thoroughbred transition program Second Stide to provide rehabilitation, retraining and committed adoptive homes to retired racehorses, broodmares and young Thoroughbreds not suited to the track. Chorleywood generally houses 16 transitioning Thoroughbreds at any one time, and may serve 80 horses over a year. The historic barn is made of traditional all-wood construction and features adjacent climate-controlled community rooms. There is also a newer barn that is a modern metal-clad indoor riding arena with exterior-facing windowed stalls and a tack/feed room. Permanent residents include stakes winner General a Rod (11th in the 2014 Kentucky Derby) and Warrior’s Club, the first horse for the Churchill Downs Racing Club in 2016 who took the 200 partners on a whirlwind ride over the course of four years winning races at marquee tracks across the country with victories at Churchill Downs, Saratoga, Oaklawn and Keeneland. Trained by Hall of Famer D. Wayne Lukas, Warrior’s Club amassed earnings of over \$850,000 including a victory in the Grade III Commonwealth Stakes at Keeneland Race Course and competed at the sport’s highest level, even participating in the Breeders’ Cup Sprint (GI).
