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**PALADIN, CHIEF WALLABEE CLOSE AS 8-1 CO-FAVORITES
AT CONCLUSION OF KENTUCKY DERBY FUTURE WAGER POOL 5**

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (Sunday, March 15, 2026) – Seven weeks in advance of the \$5 million Kentucky Derby presented by Woodford Reserve (Grade I), **Paladin**, winner of the Remsen (Grade II) and Risen Star (GII), and Fountain of Youth runner-up **Chief Wallabee** closed as 8-1 co-favorites in Pool 5 of the Kentucky Derby Future Wager (KDFW).

The **Chad Brown**-trained Paladin, who runs next in the April 4 Blue Grass (GI) at Keeneland, had \$25,772 in Win bets while the **Bill Mott**-trained Chief Wallabee, scheduled to make his next start in the Feb. 28 Florida Derby (GI), handled \$24,790 – the difference of just \$982.

In the lone Kentucky Oaks Future Wager, which was conducted concurrently with the KDFW Pool 5, unbeaten Demoiselle (GII) and Suncoast winner Zany closed as the clear 4-1 favorite.

Total handle for the KDFW pool – the fifth of six scheduled wagering pools in advance of the 1 ¼-mile Kentucky Derby – was \$391,430 (\$290,189 in the Win pool and \$101,241 in Exactas) compared to last year's \$430,006 (\$328,063 in the Win pool and \$102,003 in Exactas).

Betting on the Oaks Future Wager totaled \$76,059 (\$55,444 in the Win pool and \$20,615 in Exactas) versus 2025's \$79,974 (\$58,629 in the Win pool and \$21,345 in Exactas).

The Oaks/Derby Double, which requires bettors to correctly select the winners of both the \$1.5 million Longines Kentucky Oaks (GI) on May 1 and the next day's Derby, handled \$69,961 compared to last year's \$83,716.

Betting on all future wagers over the three-day period, which included an Oaks/Derby Future Double, was \$537,450 compared to last year's \$593,696 and 2024's \$458,269.

Through the first five pools, a total of \$1,814,956 has been bet on Derby future wagers versus last year's \$1,847,627.

The year's sixth and final Kentucky Derby Future Wager pool is set for Thursday, April 2 through Saturday, April 4. Different from the first five pools of the KDFW, Pool 6 will close prior to the first Road to the Kentucky Derby Championship Series race on April 4.
