RENEGADE 4-1, COMMANDMENT 7-1 AT CONCLUSION OF KENTUCKY DERBY FUTURE WAGER POOL 6

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (Saturday, April 4, 2026) – Four weeks in advance of the 152nd running of the \$5 million Kentucky Derby presented by Woodford Reserve (Grade I), bettors made Arkansas Derby (GI) winner **Renegade** the 4-1 favorite with Florida Derby (GI) winner **Commandment** the 7-1 second choice in the sixth and final pool of the Kentucky Derby Future Wager (KDFW).

The three-day pool closed Saturday at 6 p.m. ET in advance of the three final Road to the Kentucky Derby Championship Series races: Saturday's Blue Grass (GI), Wood Memorial (GII) and Santa Anita Derby (GI).

Total handle for the three-day April 2-4 KDFW pool – the final future wager pool in advance of the Kentucky Derby on Saturday, May 2 – was \$393,707 (\$279,468 in the Win Pool and \$114,239 in Exactas) compared to last year's \$483,121 (\$353,160 in the Win Pool and \$129,961 in Exactas).

A total of \$2,208,663 was bet on Derby and Oaks future wagers this year versus last year's \$2,330,748.

The KDFW, offered for a 28th consecutive year, enables bettors to wager on possible Kentucky Derby contenders in advance of America's greatest race at odds that could be more attractive than those available on the day of the race. The \$5 million Kentucky Derby presented by Woodford Reserve (GI) for 3-year-old Thoroughbreds will be run for the 152nd consecutive year on Saturday, May 2.

Churchill Downs Racetrack ("CDRT"), the world's most legendary racetrack, has been the home of The Kentucky Derby, the longest continually held annual sporting event in the United States, since 1875. Located in Louisville, CDRT features a series of themed race days during Derby Week, including the Kentucky Oaks, and conducts Thoroughbred horse racing during three race meets in the Spring, September, and the Fall. CDRT is located on 175 acres and has a one-mile dirt track, a 7/8-mile turf track, a stabling area, and provides seating for approximately 60,000 guests.
