Sign up for tattooing at the Churchill Downs racing office-list the horse's name, barn number, your name, and phone number. The TRPB Technician will scan the microchip to access the digital copy of the foal certificate, validate the information, verify the markings, color and gender, then take $10-14$ photos of the horse to digitally document all equine attributes. Bandages, poultice, blankets must be removed, and the horse must be named by the time the TRPB Technician is present to certify its identity. The Digital Tattoo-fee is $\$ 106$ which MUST be paid prior to the TRPB Technician performing the work. Payment can be made by Credit Card. Apple Pay or Google Pay. If arrangements are made with the Churchill Downs bookkeeper's office to provide a bookkeeper's check made out to TRPB in the appropriate amount, this check must be turned over to the Technician at the time of certification. time starter or a previously-raced horse that has not raced in the 365 days preceding the date of the selected race UNLESS such horse has completed an official work for the KHRC veterinarian or his/her designee prior to entry. Horses that have not raced within the one hundred fifty (150) days but have raced within the three hundred sixty-five (365) days preceding the date of the selected race must have an examination performed by the CDI Equine Medical Director or his/ her designee prior to entry.

Attention Trainers please make sure "In-Today" signs are hung on all horses entered to race by 7:30 am on race day

Horsemen- parking in the infield is allowed on race days but no cars or golf carts can go through the frontside tunnels during racing.
